

Grade: 4

HF - High-Frequency Words (0.5 to 3.83)

Only timed sub-test. Fast response per question to get a correct answer.

WR- Word Recognition (0.5 to 4.83)

<u>Scores can jump up</u> once decoding is mastered because this is word recognition out of context. But maximum score of high 4th grade because Spanish is phonetically regular.

PH - Phonics (0.5 to 3.83)

VO - Vocabulary (0.5 to 12.83)

Oral vocab. can be <u>high</u> for K-1st graders

SP - Spelling (0.5 to 9.83)

CO - Comprehension (0 to 12.83)

Lower because designed to predict content reading success: No look-back, non-fiction, longer passages.

Higher for EL students with strong comprehension strategy skills but low English vocabulary
