Test Queue Tab

The **Test Queue tab** is used to assign assessments to the whole class or to individual students.

Class Tab

The **Class tab** is where you create your class(es), add students, assign assessments, and view and/or print student login information.







Scores & Reports Tab

The **Scores & Reports tab** is where you can view your students' results and run reports. You can also access the teacher reports and data portal from this tab.

Instruction Tab

The **Instruction tab** is where you manage your students' Edge assignments and usage as well as the Assignments tool.





Manage Link

The **Manage link** allows you to connect with the Student Roster, Add Student, View Classes, and Add Class pages.

Profile Link

The **Profile link** allows you to manage your account profile and log out of your account.
