Steps for a "Picture Walk" Before Reading

- 1. Let your child hold the book and turn the pages.
- 2. Remind your child that he/she will not be reading the words yet.
- 3. After talking about the cover, have your child turn to the first page of the story. Tell him/her, "I want you to turn to each page and tell me what is happening in the pictures."
- 4. Let your child comment on each page. Insert some of your ideas that make sense with the pictures if your child hasn't commented on them yet.
- 5. Every so often, before your child turns the page, ask him/her, "What do you think will happen next?" Ask follow-up questions like "What makes you think that?" or comment, "That makes sense. That might happen!"
- 6. If it is a non-fiction book and has a glossary in the back, take some time to talk about the pictures/concepts that are laid out in the glossary.
